KAYLEIGH GOH

(b. 1993, Malaysia)

Trained as a painter, Kayleigh Goh's current practice emerged through her interactions with physical spaces. She received her BA in Fine Arts from the Lasalle College of Arts, Singapore in 2016, and has been actively showing in both Singapore and Malaysia since then. Needing an antidote for the hustle of everyday living, as well as the information age we live in today, Kayleigh's two-dimensional works act as "spaces" through which the viewer may catch a breather and delve deeper into their own thoughts.

Her current practice emerged through her exploration of cement and construction materials as paint. Kayleigh uses cement powder mixed with acrylic paint to bind the powder and provide a hint of colour. Her colour palette is heavily inspired by the works of Giorgio Morandi, with whom she also shares a fondness for simply being. She uses reclaimed, locally sourced wood board, skillfully exploiting their natural flaws with her chosen medium. Although the materials she uses are traditionally associated with building, these architecturally-inspired "spaces" do not necessarily evoke the same experience. Rather than being within a structure, the viewer is outside it, therefore inhabiting his or her own physical space and the metaphysical "space" provided by Kayleigh's work.
